A Contestant in the competition:

1. Must be a current resident of Alaska;
2. Must submit an application postmarked by April 16, 2020
3. Must currently be a high school freshman, sophomore, junior or senior

or

Must currently be enrolled as a freshman, sophomore, junior, or senior in college;

4. Must plan to attend high school or college in the fall of 2020 and **study voice privately**;
5. Must not be over twenty-five years of age;
6. Must prepare for performance three pieces;
7. Must provide his/her own accompanist.

First place winners in last year's (2019) competition may not compete for scholarships in the same category. However, you are welcome to perform for adjudicator comments.

After their application has been approved, each contestant will be contacted regarding the time of their performance. **Winners will be announced at the conclusion of the each division.** Note: In order to claim their prize, all winners will be required to perform at the Winners' Recital the evening of the competition - Saturday, May 16, 2020 - 7p.m. The competition and recital will be at the UAA Fine Arts Building Recital Hall, 3211 Providence Drive in Anchorage.
